



addition more than 20 percent of firms in countries such as Algeria Bangladesh Brazil China Estonia and Zambia rate poor education and work skills among their workforce Overcoming this handicap starts with more and better investments in youth The report highlights three areas to promote better investment in the future expanding opportunities enhancing capabilities and providing second chances Expanding opportunities focuses on increasing the quality of education smoothing the transition to work and providing young people with a platform for civic engagement Enhancing capabilities involves making young people aware of the consequences of their actions especially consequences that will affect them much later in life as well as building their decision making skills and giving them the right incentives Providing second chances calls for helping young people recover from missed opportunities through remedial education retraining treatment and rehabilitation
