example deconstructs cat woman which albeit a potentially subversive image in its early manifestations eventually ceases to empower the feminine lashing it rather to a burdensome stereotype Territorialized the feminine must then break free from the image in order to discover representations more capable of illuminating present day challenges The phrase dark assemblages drawn from Deleuze and Guattari s A Thousand Plateaus gestures toward societal stagnation as a decisive factor in individual evolvment Gothic fiction represents an uneven landscape in that it tenders the possibility of a social critique yet equally well lends itself to the exclusion of specific identities and practices that society brands as anomalous Pedraza s Gothic fiction is indeed subversive in that it offers readers original perceptions of modern day people and the assemblages dark or otherwise to which they belong
