In his effort to understand the developmental processes of human beings, he worked in conjunction with Mary Ainsworth who also had a keen interest in understanding the behavioral development of human beings (Isaacson & university of Carlifonia, Davis, 2006). Together, they formulated the theory of attachment, which stresses the significance of early-life experiences to the development of a child in later stages. Bowlby believed that personal development is highly influenced by family relationships, while Mary Ainsworth stressed that children need to depend on their parents before they can become independent (Isaacson & University of California, Davis, 2006).

In this theory, John Bowlby asserts that during the infancy stage, a child
