And by broadening his focus to look at typewriting as a social system as well as the typewriter as a technological form, he examines the fascinating way that the tool has actually shaped the creative process. With engaging subject matter that ranges over two hundred years of literature and culture in English, *The Iron Whim* builds on recent interest in books about familiar objects and taps into our nostalgia for a method of communication and composition that has all but vanished.
